

Bryce Pinkham is most widely known for originating the role of 'Monty Navarro' in the Tony Winning Musical *A Gentleman's Guide to Love and Murder* on Broadway, for which he was nominated for Tony, Grammy, and Drama Desk awards. He appeared in the Broadway revival of *The Heidi Chronicles* and was nominated for an Outer Critics Circle Award and a Drama League Award for Distinguished Performance in 2015. His other Broadway credits include *Ohio State Murders*, *Holiday Inn*, *Ghost*, *Bloody Bloody Andrew Jackson*, and *The Great Society*. He most recently starred in *Little Shop of Horrors* and *Benny and Joon*, a new musical adaptation of the 1993 movie starring Johnny Depp at the Old Globe Theater and *SUPERHERO* at 2nd Stage Theater in NYC. Following a successful run of *She Loves Me* with the Gulf Coast Symphony, Bryce returned to premier his new show for symphony orchestra titled *From Broadway to The West End: A Love Story* with his wife, Scarlett Strallen. Bryce will return yet again to star as Harold Hill in *The Music Man* opposite Ms. Strallen's Marian. His latest onscreen appearances include *Proven Innocent*, *Instinct*, Baz Luhrmann's Netflix series *The Get Down*, Robert De Niro's *The Comedian*, and as a series regular on PBS's Civil War drama series *Mercy Street*.
